Pick a venue – somewhere there will be plenty of footfall for your sale. This could be your office, community centre, or even your home.

Set a date and time – late mornings or mid-afternoon are a great time for something sweet, and you could even go desk-to-desk or office-to-office to increase sales!

Recruit bakers – ask as many people as possible to grab their aprons and get involved! You could even hold a bake-off contest to encourage some competition and maybe have a theme. We would also ask bakers to be aware of allergies and have precise information on ingredients.

Shout about it – make a poster with all the vital information and send, send, send! Emailing colleagues, texting family, and posting on Facebook and Instagram are all great options to spread the word.

Pricing – label your baked goods with a suggested donation; somewhere from £1–£5 per treat is ideal.
